



Director of Executive Education

Position Description

Position Summary

Reporting to the Dean of the College of Business and Economics, the Director of Executive Education is responsible for the overall strategic direction of the Energy Executive Course and other executive development programs. The Director partners with industry Executives who serve as the governing Board for the programs. The Director serves as the key university liaison in developing and fostering critical industry relationships, including identifying, recruiting, and directing industry advisory boards. The Director is responsible for the overall success of the department, including execution of strategic initiatives, budgetary oversight, and management of a team.

Unit Overview

Executive Education at the University of Idaho is located within the College of Business and Economics. Its purpose is to partner with industry to create innovative, strategically designed curricula specifically for energy industry stakeholders from across the United States and around the world. Partnering with industry ensures programming focused on providing today's and tomorrow's executives with the knowledge, skills, and vision to lead dynamic transformational change. The flagship Energy Executive Course, now in its 73rd consecutive year, is guided by a Memorandum of Understanding between the University of Idaho and the Energy Executive Course Advisory Board.

Strategic Leadership and Direction

- Provides vision and strategic leadership for the long-term trajectory and sustainability of executive education programming and directs department operations.
- Cultivates industry partnerships and leads stakeholder engagement, including identifying, recruiting, and leading industry advisory boards.
- Collaboratively develops and implements programming and initiatives in support of strategic priorities.
- Develops and implements comprehensive and coordinated recruiting strategies for all executive education programs.
- Advances program visibility through alumni engagement, strategic marketing and communication campaigns, and industry outreach.
- Provides administrative leadership including supervision of staff, financial management, and implementation of programmatic goals.

Program Design and Delivery

- Leads industry and university stakeholders in the design and delivery of competency-based curricula including identifying current issues and future trends, developing learning objectives, and assessing outcomes.
- Identifies, recruits, and directs program faculty, including negotiating contracts, developing instructional materials, and assessing learning objectives and outcomes.
- Oversees program execution to ensure stakeholder needs are met, and to capture learning for continuous improvement.

Monitoring, Evaluation, and Reporting

- Develops and monitors performance metrics to evaluate programming and advance strategic priorities by proposing modifications to existing programs and identifying new opportunities.
- Prepares and presents regular status reports for industry and university leadership.
- Reports key issues and significant events, including risk identification and risk management.

Required Qualifications

- Master's degree in business, communication, education, engineering or related field, or JD from an accredited university.
- Five years of experience leading cross-functional teams.
- Experience developing and fostering strategic relationships and partnerships across departments and organizations.
- Demonstrated ability to build partnerships and coalitions resulting in shared actions and outcomes.
- Demonstrated competence leading teams to completion of project objectives on scope, on schedule, and on budget.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

Required Licensures, Certifications or Other

- Requires regional, national, and international travel.
- Must be available to work evenings, weekends, and holidays in the execution of programs, activities, and events.
- · Must have a valid driver's license and ability to meet U of I driving requirements.

Preferred Qualifications

- PhD or terminal degree in business, energy, engineering, economics, or education.
- Experience working or collaborating in higher education.
- Demonstrated leadership of teams without direct supervisory oversight.
- Demonstrated skills in negotiation and conflict resolution.
- Experience with grant writing, surveys, data collection, and data analysis.
- Technical knowledge and skills related to energy and utilities.
- · Energy industry experience.
- Non-profit board leadership experience.

Application Process

Applicants should include 1) a letter of interest that addresses the responsibilities and qualifications described above, 2) a current resume, and 3) a list of professional references with email addresses, telephone numbers, and an explanation of your professional relationship. (References will not be contacted without prior authorization from the applicant.)
