IKEEP apprenticeships are for freshman and sophomore Indigenous undergraduates who are interested in exploring careers in education. *Apprentices are welcome from all Idaho colleges and universities!*

WHAT IS IKEEP APPRENTICESHIP?

As an IKEEP apprentice, you will be provided with a variety of mentorship opportunities such as Indigenous educators, pre-service teacher peers, IKEEP alumni, and University of Idaho faculty.

Apprentices receive scholarship support for one year and will participate in summits, talking circles and workshops that will build your understanding of Indigenous knowledge systems and community-centered education that help Indigenous students and communities thrive.

BENEFITS

- 1) Develop culturally sustaining and revitalizing practices to meet the contemporary needs of Native communities
- 2) Tailored support for Indigenous students to be change agents and nation builders
- 3) \$500 scholarship per semester (\$1000 for one academic year)
