Use of AI-Generated Content Policy

To protect the integrity, originality, and quality of our educational materials, the following guidelines apply when using AI-generated content in course development.

AI Usage Limit

No more than 30% of any course's content may be AI-generated. This includes text, quiz questions, summaries, resource descriptions, and similar materials.

Accuracy and Verification

You must **thoroughly review all AI-generated content to ensure it is accurate, relevant, and appropriate**. Course creators are responsible for confirming that AI-generated material meets the same standards as original content.

Transparency

Clearly identify all AI-generated sections when submitting materials for internal review.

Supplemental Use Only

AI-generated content should supplement—not replace—your subject-matter expertise and instructional design. Whenever possible, use original, cited sources as primary resources, with AI-generated materials serving only as introductions, explanations, or summaries.

Quality Expectations

AI-generated content may receive additional scrutiny to maintain high quality and academic rigor. Non-compliant materials may require revision or removal.
