

# **VANDAL LIVING - PACKING LIST**

Not sure what to bring with you to the University of Idaho? Use this list as a starting point for the essentials you'll need. We recommend reaching out to your roommate before move-in to coordinate any shared items.

#### **BEDDING AND CLOTHING**

- ☐ Bedding: Sheets, pillows and pillowcases, comforter, mattress topper and blankets
- ☐ Bed Size: Twin XL (W36" X L80" X H7")
- ☐ Clothing for all seasons, Moscow typically starts getting cold mid-October and warms up in late April. It does snow in Moscow.

### **SCHOOL SUPPLIES & ELECTRONICS**

- ☐ School supplies: pens, pencils, paper, markers, stapler, scissors, school backpack
- ☐ Personal laptop (Computer labs are available)
- ☐ Computer necessities: Surge protector, flash drive and mouse
- ☐ Headphones and charging cables

### **TOILETRIES/CLEANING SUPPLIES**

- ☐ Toilet paper, if you live in Wallace, the NCC or LLC
- ☐ Personal hygiene items: Toothbrush, toothpaste, brush, shampoo, deodorant, etc.
- □ Towels and shower shoes
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ High efficiency laundry detergent
- ☐ Assorted cleaning supplies

#### **OTHER**

- ☐ Organizational items: Under-bed storage drawers, closet organizer, hangers, etc.
- □ Fan
- ☐ Small vacuum
- □ Shower caddy or bag
- ☐ Decorative items and command strips to hang things (Wall space can be limited)
- ☐ Coffee cup, cutlery, plates, microwaveable containers, pots and pans for cooking in community kitchens
- ☐ Bicycle, helmet, bike lock

## ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

- ☐ Refrigerator and microwave (all rooms have both)
- ☐ Lithium-ion batteries used in e-bikes/scooters and similar devices are prohibited per campus fire safety policies. We encourage you to leave these items at home.
- ☐ Heaters, candles, and incense
- ☐ Any open coil/open flame appliances (toaster ovens, hotplates, grills etc.)
- ☐ Air Fryers and Instant Pots
